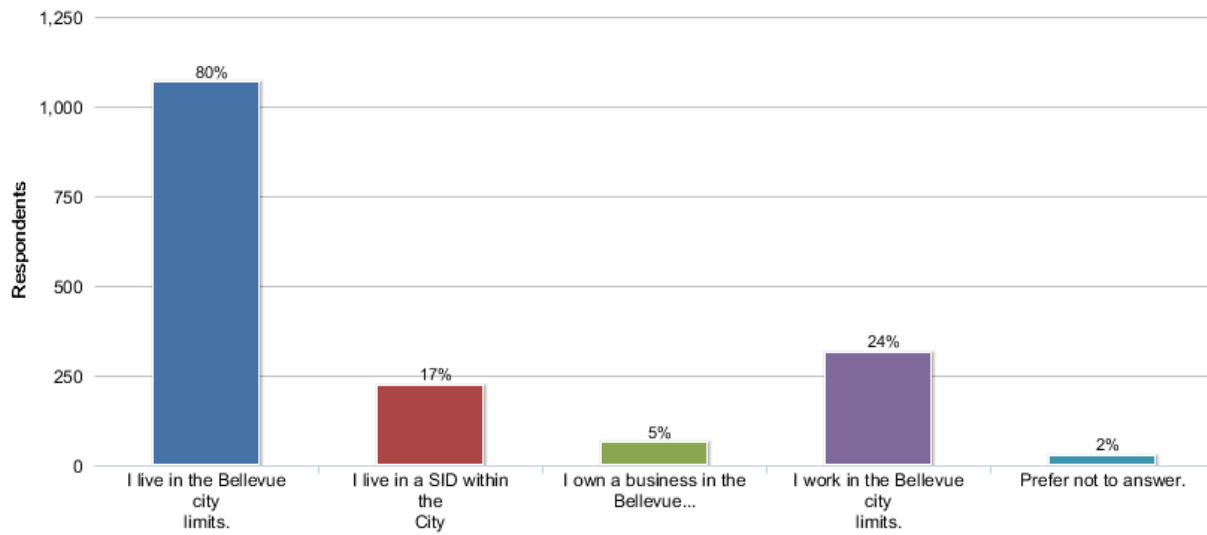

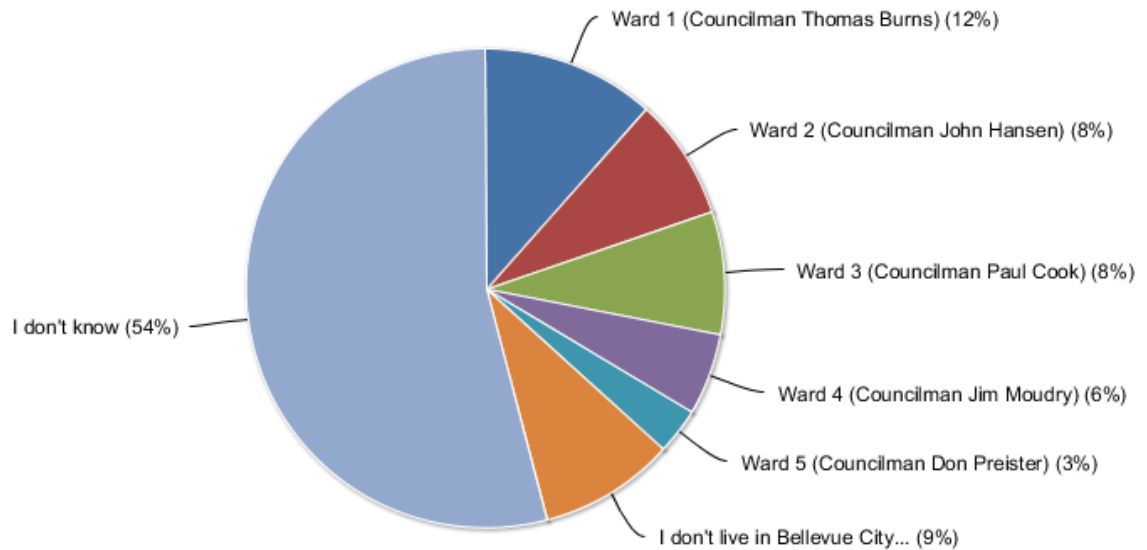

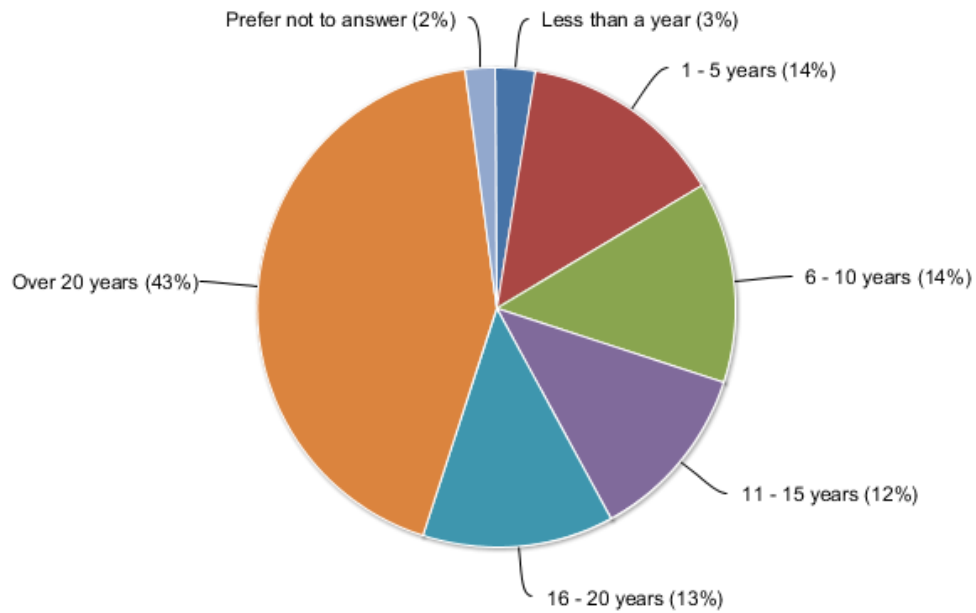
What City Council Ward do you live in? (Please note that Bellevue City At-Large Member represents the city as a whole and is not listed below.)

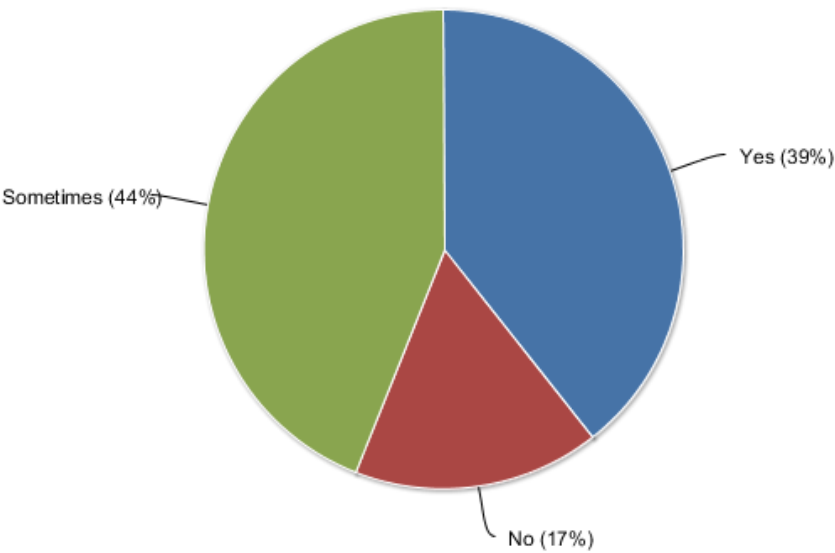
How long have you lived in Bellevue?

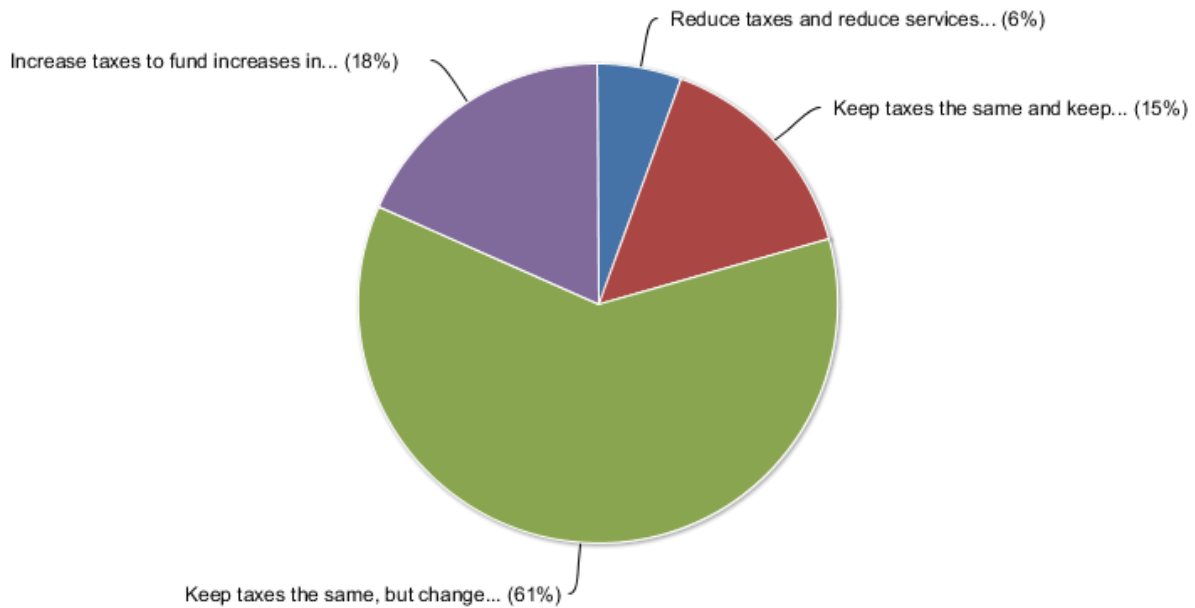

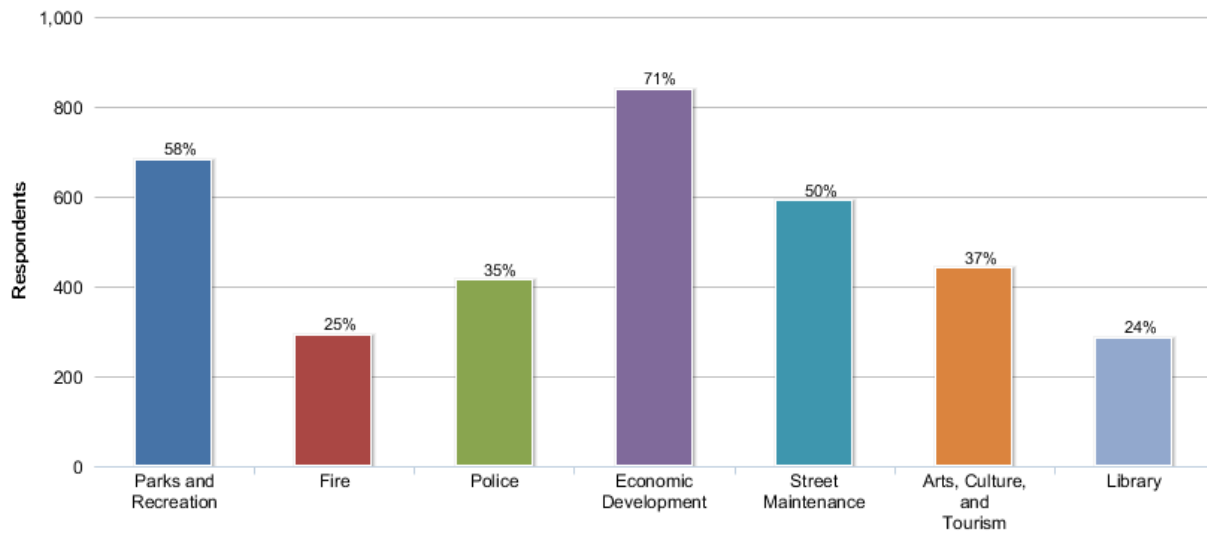
Please select the response below which best identifies your preference for taxes and spending when it comes to operations and infrastructure.

What areas do you think should be the top priorities for the City of Bellevue as it prepares for the 2017-2018 budget (Pick three).

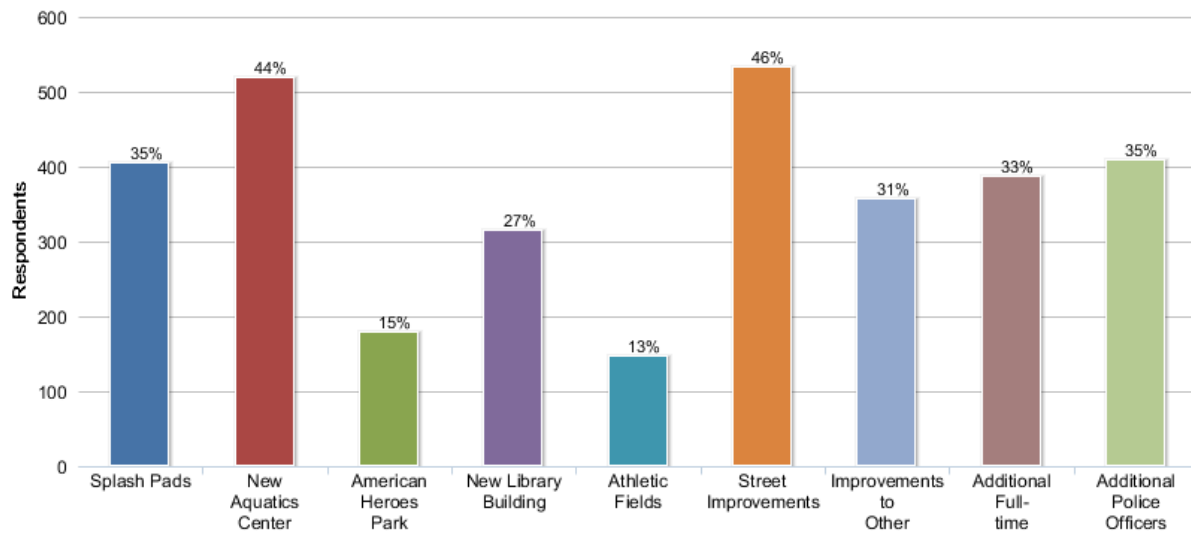

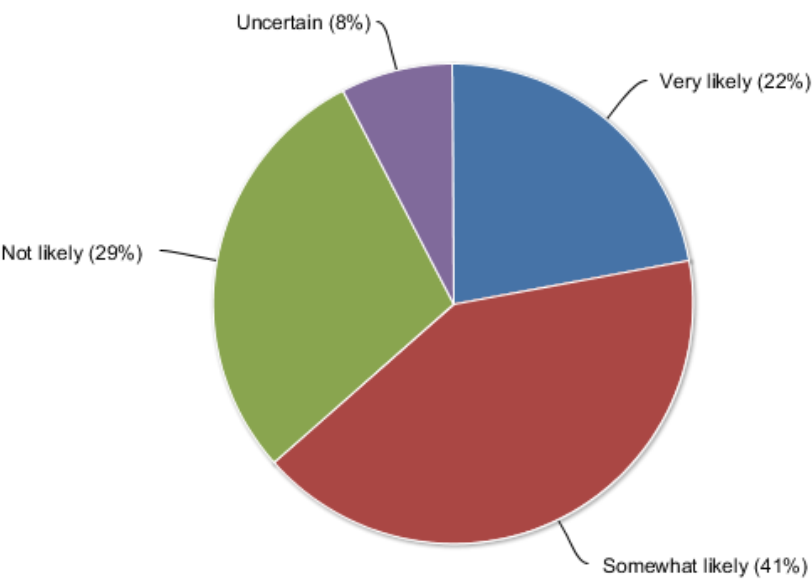
With limited financial resources available, which specific proposed projects do you feel should be a priority for the City of Bellevue? Please pick three.

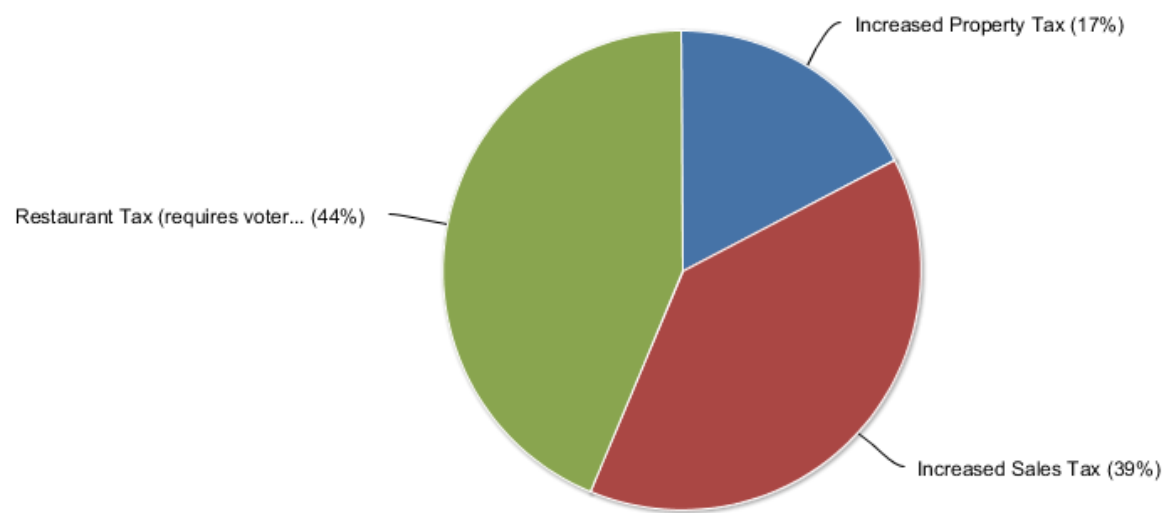
How likely are you to support a tax increase to fund the top priorities?
