Haworth Park Campground Update

As of September 1, 2020, the City of Bellevue has entered into a Public/Private Partnership with local resident, Roger Winsor, for the sole purpose of establishing and maintaining a campground at Haworth Park. This partnership only entails the land at Haworth Park that had been utilized as a campground prior to the 2019 floods.

Winsor Cove Camping & Recreation in Haworth Park will be a private campground open to the public for seasonal and day-to-day campsite rentals.
